



Financial Summary

December 31, 2021 Actual Pledge & Plate Offerings and Investment Income are \$24,090 with Expenditures being \$12,651 for a positive cash flow of \$11,439 vs the expected positive cash flow of \$15,367. YTD Actual Pledge & Plate Offerings and Investment Income are \$157,224 as compared to the budget of \$163,700 for a negative difference of (\$6,476). YTD Actual Pledge and Plate Offerings are \$157,224 as compared to the previous year of \$163,997 for a negative difference of (\$6,773). YTD Actual Expenditures are \$147,250 vs. \$164,692 budgeted for a positive difference of \$17,442.
